

GYS COVID Guidelines- Updated 1/6/22

These are in effort to help minimize exposure for our GYS coaches, players, and families. We are fortunate to be able to use Gatesville ISD facilities and have worked in partnership with the district to develop these guidelines.

- Symptom screening of players and spectators is the responsibility of the parent/guardian. If your player has fever 100+ or is symptomatic, please do not participate in GYS activities. If your player is not feeling well, please let your coach know. This also applies to spectators at the games.

- COVID positive test results or positive exposure- it is the parent's responsibility to notify the players coach or GYS board member if the player tests positive to COVID or has a COVID positive exposure. The GYS board will assist the coach in confidentiality contacting other teammates who were in close contact.

- Return to GYS activities: positive exposure- negative test after 5 days from exposure or 10 day quarantine; COVID positive result- 10 day quarantine.

- All protocols/guidelines are subject to change according to local county health authority recommendations.
